## Policies and Expectations (Infants— 6th Grade)



### Parent Expectations

- ⇒ Parents will serve in some area of Children and Family Ministry at least once every six weeks.
- ⇒ Parents will pick up their children immediately following classes. (Kid Zone - Preschool pick up in Nazareth, K/1 pick up in Galilee, Grades 2 thru 5 pick up in Fellowship Hall.)
- ⇒ Parents will not bring children to programs when: they have a fever of 100 degrees or higher, vomiting or diarrhea within 24 hours, unknown rashes, discharge out of eyes or ears, impetigo, measles, active chicken pox or being treated with an antibiotic for less than 24 hours.  
**\*Nursery**- includes above and the first 3 days of a cold, nasal drainage with discoloration or sore throat.
- ⇒ Parents will communicate with Leadership any pertinent emotional, health, physical concerns, custodial issues regarding children.
- ⇒ Parents will communicate with Shepherds/Leaders when children are absent over 2 consecutive weeks.

### Child Expectations

- ⇒ RESPECT for yourself: no hats, inappropriate clothing, language or behavior.
- ⇒ RESPECT for other children: no name calling, teasing or unwanted physical contact.
- ⇒ RESPECT for Leaders/Shepherds: obeying, no interrupting or disrespectful language. Students must be with their Leaders/Shepherds unless directed otherwise.
- ⇒ RESPECT for the church building and property: no running in halls, littering, damage to classrooms, halls or bathrooms. No climbing on chairs, tables or in cupboards.
- ⇒ RESPECT for the Lord: by participating in large group, prayer, worship, small group activities and bringing their Bibles each week.

**These items are not allowed: electronics, mobile phone, food, candy. These items will be taken and left at the registration tables to be picked up after program. \*Nursery - please refer to the nursery information sheet for details on personal items.**

### Disciplinary Procedure

- 1) Child is verbally warned.
- 2) Child is separated from the group.
- 3) Child is removed from classroom setting (Elementary: coach is contacted and parents are contacted during the week. Preschool and Nursery: parents are contacted immediately).
- 4) If on-going misbehavior occurs, parents will be contacted to pick up child.
- 5) If deemed necessary, parents must attend conference with Shepherd/Leader, Coach and Staff before child can return to class. Parents may be asked to accompany child to class.
- 6) Refusal of parents to comply with these procedures may lead to suspension from the program.



## Project 72 Student Expectations (Grades 7 - 12)

1. **Be where you're supposed to be.** This includes arriving to events on time and staying within the boundaries set for you by the leadership.
2. **Respect people and property.** Whether we are on church campus or off, uncooperative, unkind or destructive behavior towards people or property will not be tolerated. Any damages will be paid by those responsible.
3. **The Purple Rule is in effect.** Guys are blue. Girls are pink. No making purple. Enough said.
4. **Modesty is the Best Policy.** Dress modestly. No spaghetti strap tanks, tight clothing, or T-shirts with inappropriate messages or graphics. One piece bathing suits at all events.
5. **The following items are not allowed & will be confiscated:** Electronics: Cell Phones, video/electronic games, TV's, radios, CD/MP3/iPODS, or cassette players; Pornography / questionable reading material; Fireworks; Weapons, including knives; Drugs, alcohol or tobacco products.
